	The meeting was adjourned to allow members of the public the opportunity raise any concerns in relation to the Parish					
39/2024	Public Participation Five parishioners were in attendance to raise their concerns in relation to a Certificate of Lawful Development application for proposed use as Class C2 Residential Institution at Kiln Croft, Welton. The Chair responded "the Parish Council had not received any communication from the Planning Authority as they do not usually consult for "proposed use". I have been advised that it is for the Planning Authority to determine whether the change from C3 residential to C2 residential is lawful, and they make this decision based upon specific criteria. If the determination is that the application is lawful, then there is no requirement for further planning permission. Conversely if the determination is that the application is not lawful, then a full planning application would then need to be made by the applicant, which will be advertised and to which you could make comment to the planning authority. A request was made to include the Kiln Croft application on the Parish Council meeting agenda, but unfortunately the request was made too late to be included on the agenda (due to legal requirements in publicising meetings)".					
	The Planning Officer at Cumberland Council had advised that as this is a certificate of proposed development rather than a certificate of existing use, we do not generally consult with the Parish Council. However, I have requested a 14-day consultation to be sent to the Parish Council.					
	Concerns were also raised relating to the re-consultation application FUL/2024/0098 at Hazel Gill Farm, Welton for change of use and extension of agricultural storage barns to create dwelling.					
	The Chair reiterated that for residents comments and observations to be taken into consideration by the Planning Authority, it is necessary for residents to make these directly to the Planning Authority.

A temporary road closure has been put in place to allow Cumberland Council to carry out highway works commencing on 2nd September 2024 and anticipated to take 29 days to complete. Further notification from Cumberland Council advised that the works will now be in place until 30 September 2025.				
	Sebergham Bridge It was noted that following the damage caused to the parapet on the bridge a work ticket had been issued by Cumberland Council for the rebuilding work. Members discussed whether improved signage on the approach to the bridge could be implemented. This will be raised with Highways. The visibility issue raised by a member of the public at the last meeting had been reported to Highways.

The event would be advertised in the Parish Magazine with details formalised at the next meeting.
